"The future of the Church is in those not currently in it".

Said Daniel Ang, Director of the Sydney Centre for Evangelisation in the Catholic Archdiocese of Sydney, to the Divine Renovation conference on Saturday 20 November 2021. Daniel was on a panel with Fr James Mallon, well known founder of Divine Renovation.

Fr James pointed to two major aspects of Church life: maintenance, and mission. We need both. However if our focus tends to be on maintenance only – looking after those already in the Church, maintaining buildings and the like – with no or little mission outreach, then, as Daniel reminds us, our parishes will be closing within a generation (if you don't believe him, have a quick look around!).

Fr James pointed out that the Eucharist (going to Mass), will not of itself move a parish toward mission. What is needed is the power of the Holy Spirit, the Primacy of Evangelization and the Best of Leadership.

While we have 'positional leaders' in the Church, what we need more than anything are 'character leaders': influencers, people who lead out of love and respect for others.

Fr James pointed out that "the call to mission is addressed by Jesus to all the baptised". He suggests the clergy have assimilated what is proper to the priesthood of all the baptised: the result, you hear people offering to "do for Father", or people will "do nothing without the permission of Father".

And our kids have walked away from the Church in droves, not from Faith, but from the Church. It's up to us to bring their voice into our future. You know what your kids and grandkids are saying about the Church, about why they may not go to Mass, why they get married

outside the Church, why they don't get their kids baptised. One thing we can do is give them a voice – contribute to the *Synod.* Pope Francis wants the 'positional leaders', the Bishops to hear from them.

The new **traffic light system** will allow people to gather in churches under certain conditions **after 2 December**; Wellington South is expected to be on ORANGE. This means there will be no restriction on numbers in the Church and no need for registration.

- All parishioners must show a My Vaccine Pass at the door, which will be verified. (You can download this onto your phone, or produce a paper copy with the QR code on it)
 To get a My Vaccine Pass call 0800 222 478. Please have your NHI number ready you can find this on a hospital letter, a prescription or prescription receipt.
 OR go to https://mycovidrecord.health.nz/ to sign up for a My Health Account.
- From 4 December a separate 6pm Vigil Mass at St
 Anne's will be open to vaccinated and unvaccinated alike
 (no proof of vaccine required). A maximum of 50 people
 allowed and you may need to register.
- We will also continue with measures designed to minimise the risk of transmitting Covid-19.
 - ◆ Please bring your own mask
 - Scan in at the door
 - Communion only in the hand
 - No holy water for blessing
 - No shared hymn or other books.
